

TO COMPLETE THIS ACTIVITY YOU NEED:

per player

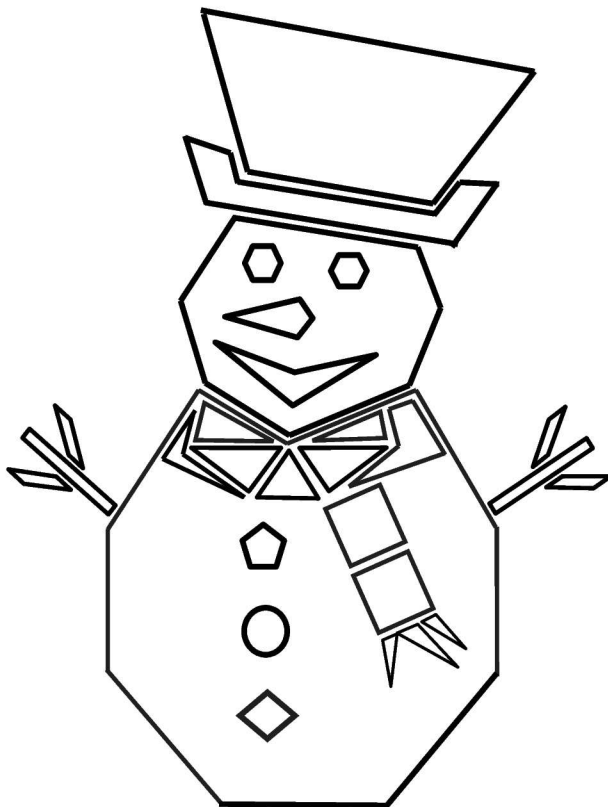

AIM: The first player to complete a copy of their snowman is the winner.

HOW TO PLAY: Players take turns. On your turn roll two dice and multiply them together. Look for your answer in the **KEY** to see which shape you can add to your snowman. A maximum of one shape can be added on any turn. You can only add facial features once his head is drawn, clothing or arms once his body is drawn, and fingers once his arms are drawn.

Your Snowman

Go through the **KEY** and make sure you can identify all the shapes that are listed. The scarf contains **all** 4 types of triangles – can you identify all of them? You will only be able to begin drawing when you have rolled the numbers you need to draw the Snowman's hat, head or body. Note that a Quadrilateral is **any** four-sided shape. If you've already drawn all the shapes for the product you have rolled, your turn ends!
